

The one-year MSc in Advanced General Dental Practice has been designed to support dentists who wish to gain a Master of Science postgraduate qualification and work in the UK for up to 5 years.

This course aims to build on a dentists' primary BDS qualification, allowing them to extend and deepen their analytical and practical skills, which underpin their practice. Students will prepare for the ORE or LDS through focussed tuition as well as learn evidence-based practice within complex multidisciplinary teams. This includes Implantology and Digital Dentistry. On completion, students will be equipped with the appropriate skills to treat challenging general dental cases.

As part of the course, we support our students to get registered with the GDC as Dental Therapists and help them to gain employment whilst they study.

- Practice dentistry legally in the UK
- Work as a dental therapist whilst you study
- Navigate the NHS and the UK interview process

Entry Requirements

- Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS), or equivalent, or other approved qualification in a cognate area
- Degree transcripts
- 2 references
- Copy of passport
- Copy of dental licence

English Language Requirements

Our courses require a minimum English level of IELTS 6.0 or equivalent, with no band score under 5.5. If you do not meet the English language requirement, we will give you a conditional offer subject to you meeting the requirement before the commencement of the course.
